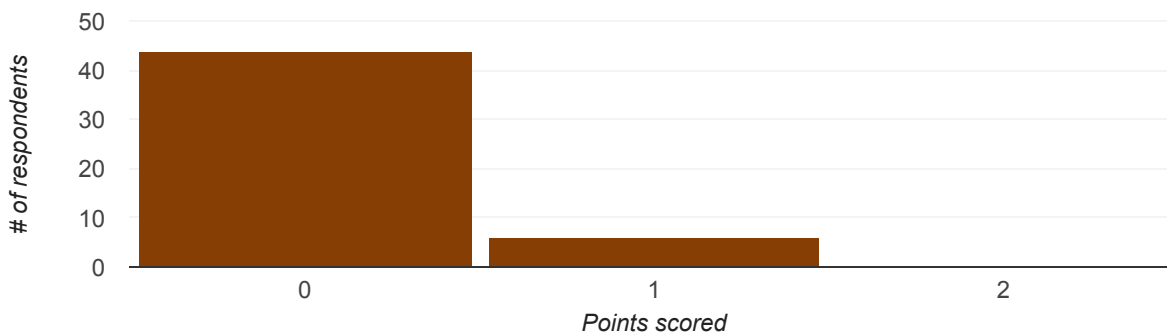

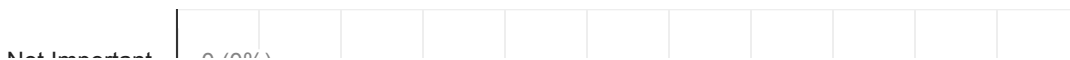

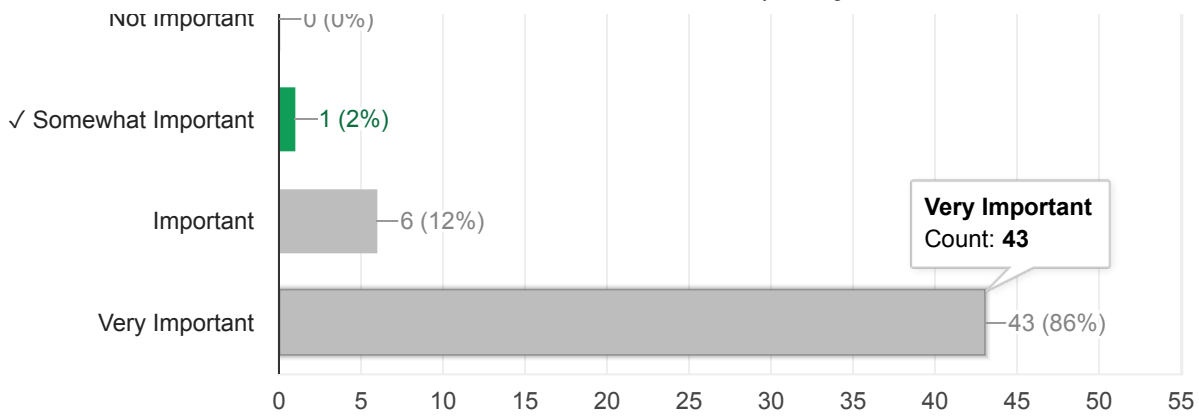

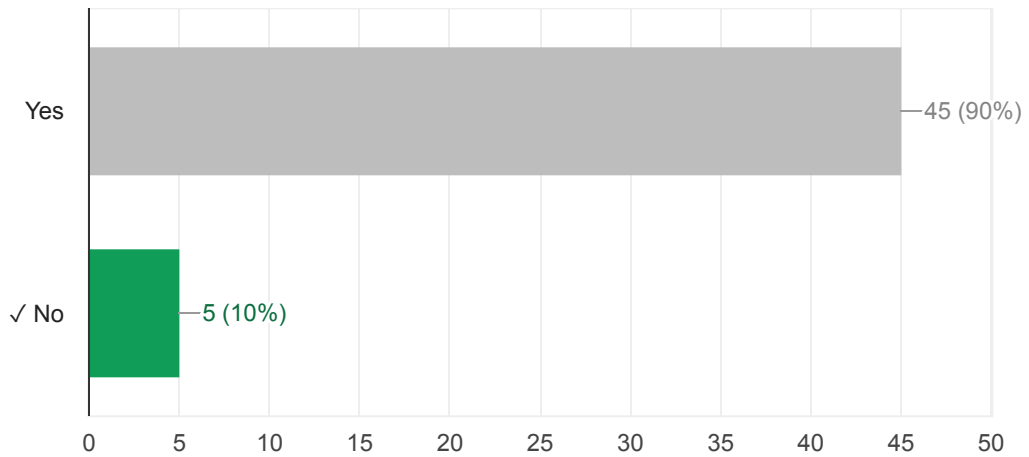

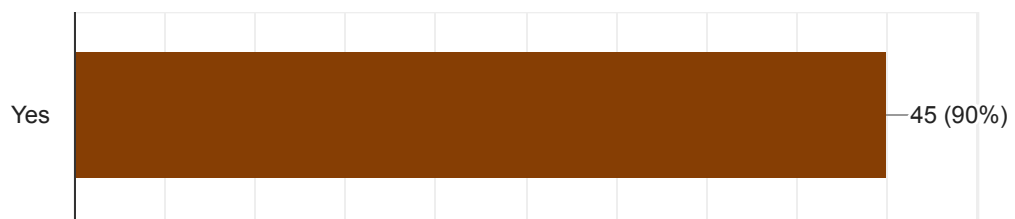

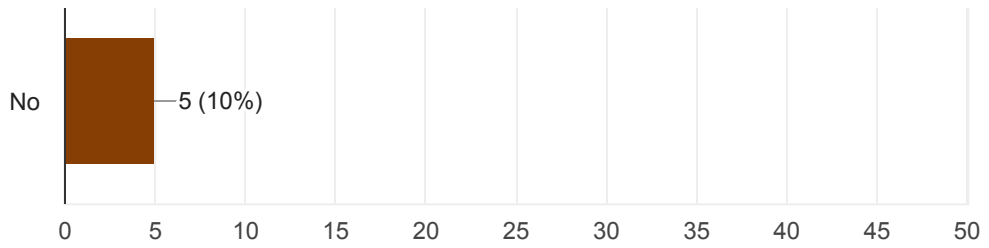

Do you feel welcome at your child's school?

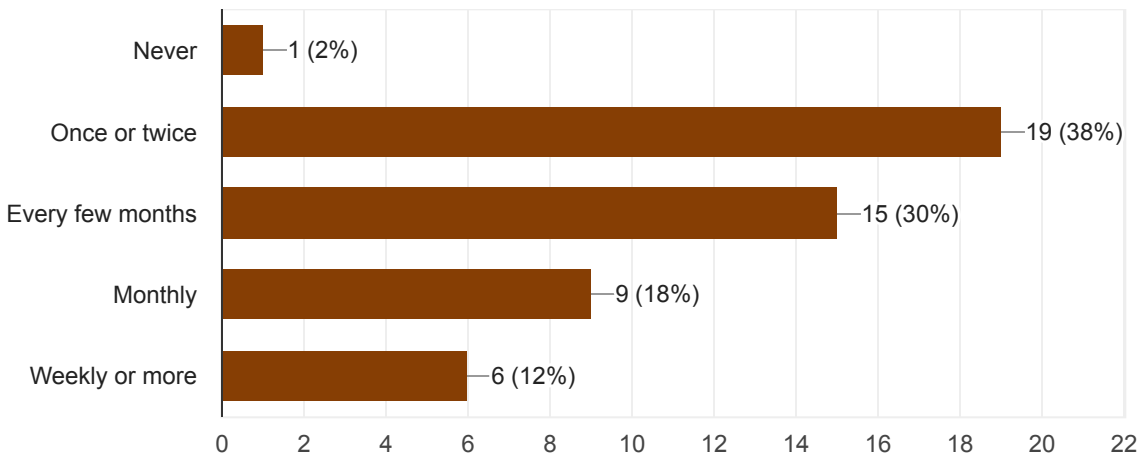

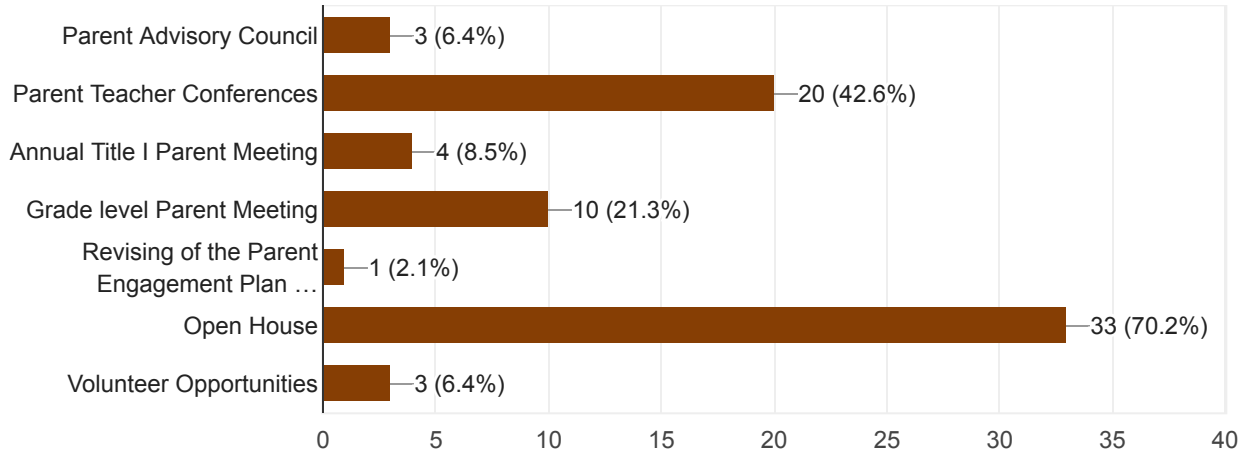
When is the best time for you to attend a school event for parents?

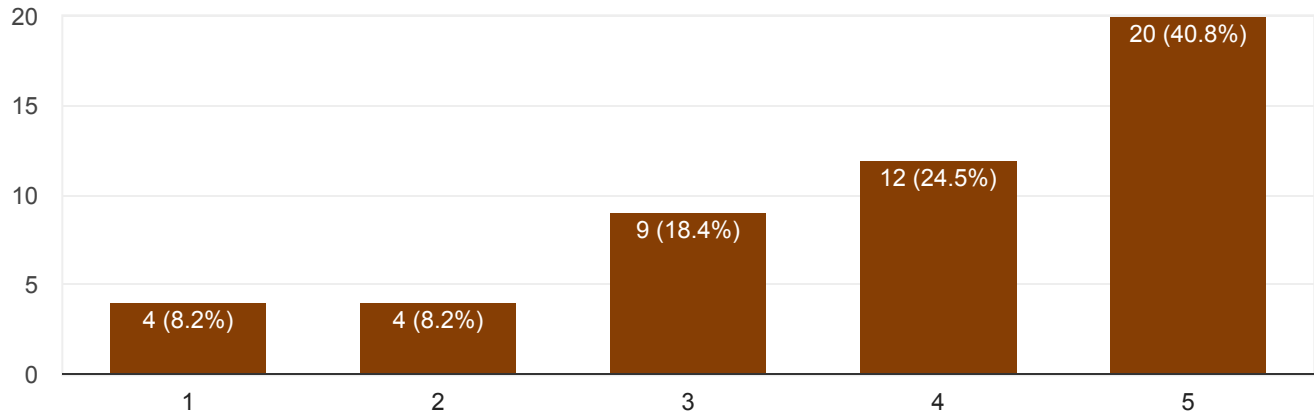


Do you receive written communication from the school in a format and language that is understandable?

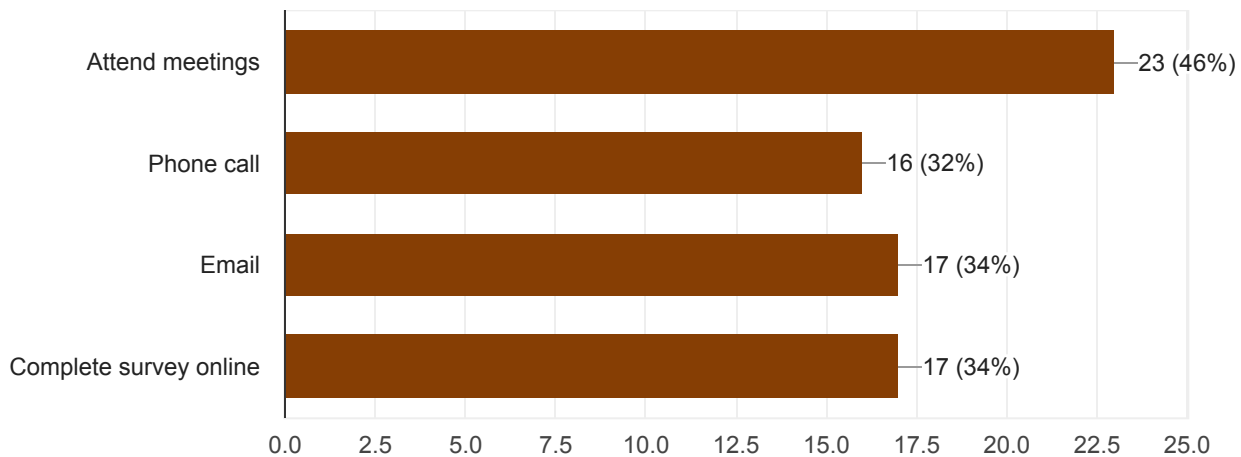
How confident are you about your understanding of the content that your child is taught in the classroom, and what your child is expected to know by the end of the school year?

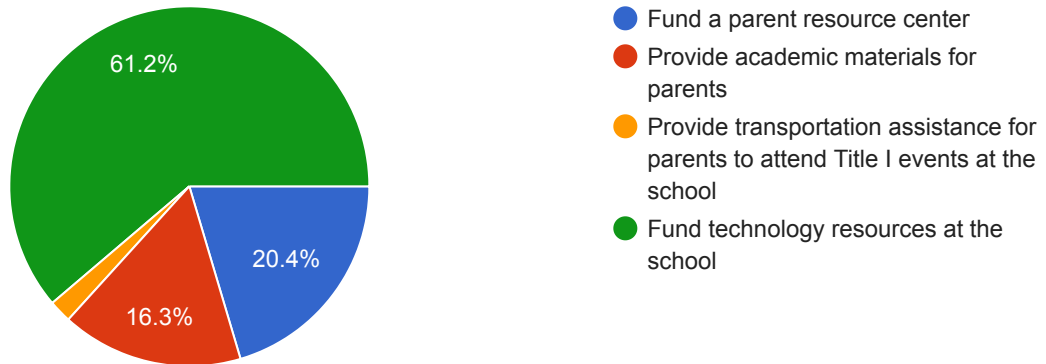
